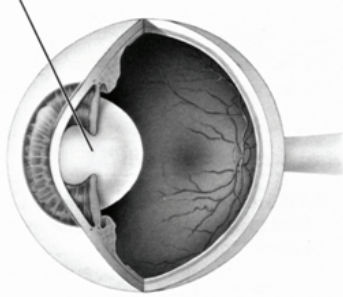

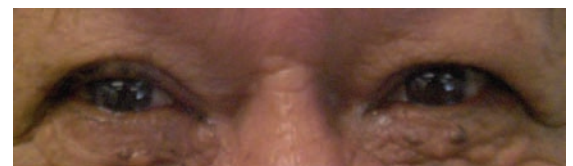
Specialized Contact Lenses

Our optometrist, Dr. Louie, works with many patients who are not candidates for LASIK or PRK surgery and have difficulty getting fitted for contact lenses.

Recently Dr. Louie fit one of our Maui patients with a prosthetic lens after the patient suffered eye trauma. The resulting scar in the right eye was opaque so that the two eye colors were very different. This very obvious scar left the patient feeling self conscious.
